BROKEN TOENAIL

NOT EATING FOR MORE THAN 24 HOURS

MAJOR EYE ISSUE (IF OUT OF SOCKET, IT IS CRITICAL)

URINARY ISSUE

IF YOUR PET IS EXPERIENCING ONE OF THESE SYMPTOMS, IT IS NOT AN EMERGENCY, BUT YOUR PET SHOULD BE SEEN WITHIN 24 HOURS

MINOR CASES

EAR, SKIN AND ANAL GLAND ISSUES

MINOR EYE ISSUE

COUGHING, SNEEZING, UPPER
RESPIRATORY

DIARRHEA ONLY
